Submission of Papers or Abstracts

Full papers as well as extended abstracts may be submitted. All proposals must include the following information: An abstract of up to 200 words, authors' full name and affiliation, contact details for corresponding author such as address, phone, and e-mail.

All papers or abstracts should be submitted electronically to the organising committee via the e-mail address macciinaugural2012@zew.de as doc or pdf files (preferably pdf) no later than 1 February 2012. Proposals must be in English. Authors of accepted papers or abstracts will be notified no later than 15 February 2012. Presenters may kindly be asked to discuss another paper. Young researchers are particularly encouraged to submit proposals.
