

Alessandra Atripaldi graduated at LUISS Guido Carli law school in Rome and completed her academic career with an LL.M. at the Institute for Law and Finance in Frankfurt am Main, and a PhD at Luigi Bocconi University in Milan; she was also a visiting scholar at the Stanford Law School in California.

Alessandra is an experienced financial lawyer admitted to the bar of the highest Courts in Italy. She started her career as a trainee at the European Investment Bank and at the European Central Bank. After joining the European Commission as official, in January 2022 she was appointed as Deputy Head of the same Securities Market Unit. Since September 2024, she has taken on the role of Deputy Head of the Capital Markets Unit
